liquor license not too long after Atlantic City ushered in casino gaming...from there he built a nightclub and a small empire including an exclusive hotel right in the heart of Atlantic City's downtown district.

His goal was to simply help transform Atlantic City's tattered image into the place to be. So along with seven other midtown businesses they formed the Metropolitan Business & Civic Association (MBCA), over which Schultz has presided as president, since its inception sixteen years ago. Through that time, his life partner, Gary Hill, has been a driving force within the MBCA. His impeccable attention to detail is apparent at every function. Together, the pair have earned the trust, respect and loyalty of the entire community. For it has always been the community they've tried to better.

Now, they've decided to take philanthropy in Atlantic City to a whole new level. The Schultz-Hill Foundation has been established to promote and support arts, history and education in South Jersey. In an effort to foster appreciation and awareness, one of the primary goals is to provide educational scholarships, direct grants and funding for Students. Allowing them the opportunity to nurture a given talent, or simply broaden their understanding of our world and social heritage.

The Foundation achieves this through close involvement with academic and performing arts centers. It is this mission, and the trustees' personal beliefs, that drive them to contribute back to the local communities that have been so good to them.

The Foundation is a 501(c)(3) formed in 2003, and the Foundation headquarters will be located in an Atlantic City historical landmark known as the Professional Arts Building (circa 1930) on 1616 Pacific Avenue that was recently renamed the Schultz-Hill Foundation Professional Arts Building. They are currently under construction on this project.
