CRITERIA

The DINA Awards will be given to individuals who meet the basic criteria:

- a) Completed Application
- b) Resume or synopsis of academic, non-academic (sports, arts and music clubs, theater participation, and volunteer work), or synopsis on how this **DINA ARTS Grant** will help promote the ARTS with your non-profit organization (Include a description of use of grant for your organization)
- c) Complete for **STUDENT APPLICANT** an essay on the value and future of either their arts, historical or educational program in which they are enrolled. Include high school transcript for current high school student; and all college transcripts if current college student.
- d) Complete for **TEACHER APPLICANT** a letter of description and examples of how their artistic or historical program is utilized in their current school.

Letters of Recommendation are NOT necessary but may be attached to applications.
